Good afternoon all,

I write this email to ensure that the expectations of the College and myself are very clear in relation to the use of cars by students. The College rule concerning the use of cars states that "Students, while attending the College, normally will not be permitted the use of a car. Exceptions will require the written permission of the Deputy Headmaster."

We realise that there are a number of students who have their driving licence and in some cases it may be necessary for families to seek permission for students to be able to drive themselves to and from school. As I am sure you can appreciate, we have and need very strict rules regarding the use of motor vehicles by our students.

I wish to make it clear that no student is to drive to or from school during the week or to and from sport or any other school activity unless permission has first been sought by the student's parents from the Deputy Headmaster, Br Anthony.

Further to this, no boy is to get into a motor vehicle driven by another student unless permission has first been sought by the student's parents from the Deputy Headmaster, Br Anthony.

Requests for such permission may be submitted by email to Br Anthony at aboyd@joeys.org and permission will be granted and some conditions communicated to students concerning the use of the motor vehicle which must be adhered to.

We need to be very clear that any boy who cannot adhere to the above will be suspended for one week.
