Readily available and aggressively marketed online, exposure to pornography is now mainstream. Pornography has become a default sex educator for many young people, with serious implications for their capacity to negotiate free and full consent, for mutual respect, sexual health, and gender equality.

This session will be led by Maree Crabbe, Director of the Violence Prevention Project: Reality & Risk: Pornography, Young people and Sexuality. Maree is Co-Producer and Co-Director of the documentary films *Love and Sex in an age of Pornography*, broadcast on SBS Australia and in ten other countries. She is also an author of *In the Picture* - a whole school resource to assist secondary schools to address the influence of explicit sexual imagery. Maree's articles on young people, sexuality and pornography have been published online and in print media.
