### SPECTATORS AT SPORT THIS WEEKEND

St Joseph's College has decided that some spectators are permitted to attend the games on Saturday against Newington.

### COVID PROTOCOLS

The following protocols have been put in place to ensure the safety of all players, coaches, staff, officials and spectators attending school sport at St Joseph's College, Hunters Hill. We ask that you take note and respect the protocols established at St Joseph's College in accordance with advice from AHPPC, NSW Health and CSNSW.

### SPECTATORS

#### Outdoor Venues: Two Spectators per student

- College Cricket Ovals
- College Basketball Courts
- Park Cricket Ovals
- Park Tennis Courts

#### Indoor Venues: One Spectator per student (team lists provided for each game)

- College Indoor Basketball Gym: Please note that in the mezzanine area upstairs, there is a maximum of 20 spectators permitted in this area during any game.
- Arriving players for the next game may sit on the seats at the southern end on the ground floor.

*Please note, NO Student Spectators are permitted unless they are a reserve or have been appointed to official roles e.g. bench duty, scorer, etc*

### CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

- All spectators, staff, officials and players are required to check-in to the St Joseph's College facilities by scanning the Services NSW QR Code and completing the relevant details.
- Entry point for the tennis courts & the Park cricket fields:
  - o Everyone enters via Augustine St Gates.
  - o No parking will be available inside the Park Ovals for spectators or players.
  - o Officials, staff & coaches are permitted to park within the Park Ovals.
  - o The QR Codes will be at these gates.
  - o Please follow directions of security guards at this gate.
- Entry points for the basketball courts & College cricket fields:
  - o Everyone enters via Gladesville or Mark St Gates.
  - o No parking will be available inside the College grounds for spectators or players.
  - o Officials, staff & coaches are permitted to park within the College grounds.
  - o The QR Codes will be at these gates.
  - o Please follow directions of security guards at this gate.
- Spectators, players, staff & officials are asked to remain at the grounds only for the duration of their game, and to leave as soon as possible after the conclusion of their fixture.



- All attendees will be required to sanitise their hands upon entry to SJC campus.
- Spectators, officials and staff are expected to maintain 1.5m physical distancing.
- Security and Joeys' staff will be in place to ensure all attendees comply with these rules to ensure the safety of those attending the fixtures.

### **PRE-ATTENDANCE AGREEMENT**

Please do not attend St Joseph's College, Hunters Hill sports fixtures as either a player, coach, staff, official or spectator if you:

- are showing signs and symptoms of COVID-19.
- feel unwell or exhibit flu-like symptoms.
- have been in contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19.
- are at a high health risk – including the elderly and those with pre-existing conditions.
- Live or have visited a current COVID-19 hotspot.

### **STUDENT AND SPECTATOR AMENITIES**

- These will be separated with clearly marked signs.
- Spectators at the College use amenities at the back of the Hall or the base of the Science block. Spectators at the park use amenities behind the grandstand or the tennis courts.
- Students at the College use the change rooms or classroom amenities. Students at the Park use change rooms.

### **PLAYER INFORMATION**

Change rooms will only be open for use of the toilet. Players will not be permitted to meet or congregate inside.

We ask that players please:

- Arrive in playing uniform and avoid sharing any uniform items.
- Bring their own clearly marked drink bottle – no sharing permitted.
- Bring and use their own hand sanitiser.
- DO NOT SPIT under any circumstances.
- Do not engage in huddles, handshakes or high fives.

### **FOOD, DRINKS AND AMENITIES:**

- No canteens or barbecues will be operating on site.
- Toilets & facilities will be cleaned throughout the day
- Good hygiene practices must be adhered to while using all facilities.
- Hand sanitiser tables will be placed around the campus.



### **ATTENDANCE AT 'AWAY' VENUES:**

Please be aware that Covid protocols vary between venues. We need to ensure we follow the protocols in place at each individual venue. We ask that those teams, staff and spectators respect the protocols in place there. We expect everyone to follow best practice when it comes to hygiene.

This week, St Joseph's College has the following 'Away' fixtures:

- Water Polo games against St Augustine's at Drummoyne pool.
- Some Basketball, Cricket & Tennis games at Newington (two spectators per student at outdoor venues; one spectator per student indoors). Please note that this is subject to change.
- Some basketball games at Shore (two spectators per student)
- Swimming at Lane Cove.
- SLS at Queenscliff Beach
